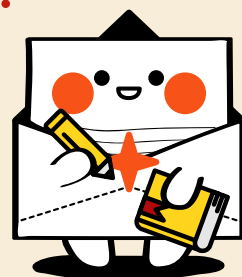

I am Jo Hyun Woo, level 1 in English and math. When studying math, I solved 20 math problems everyday to keep my senses rather than do advanced studying. Then I wrote in my wrong answer notebook and kept making up for my weak points. I did not waste time on problems I know well, and put in effort to use my time efficiently on questions I was weak on. For English, because the difficult vocabulary blocked my way as my grade when up, I memorized 15 words everyday and did not slack off in memorizing.

Q Mentor's studying method (math)

Writing wrong question notebook

Like you are writing to your future self about the parts you have missed!

I wrote 8 questions on two pages and wrote on the next page in small letters answers and hints to each questions. Hints such as, 'you need to look at the x-value again slowly!' was written like a letter to my future self so that I did not forget about it.

How to use the wrong question notebook

Checking if you solve the questions written in the wrong question notebook by yourself 2 weeks later!

For calculating mistake questions, I focused on not making the same mistakes by marking errors in the problem-solving process in red when writing wrong question notebook, and made sure to check after 2 weeks if I could solve the question I have written in the wrong answer notebook, so that I did not make the same mistake.

Q Mentor's studying method (English)

Learning all meanings of words with double meanings!

I had the difficulty interpreting sentences because I knew the word but did not know the additional meaning, so I tried to learn the various meaning each words had other than their representative meaning. For example, it is difficult to translate if you know the meaning of benefit as only benefit, but if you know the other various meanings, such as favor, advantage, allowance (subsidy), insurance money, beneficial, and profit, you will not have any difficulty interpreting the sentence.

Parent's support

I shared a lot with my parents about student record activities. They advised me which activities are good to do, which activities I am interested in and can be active in, and which activities are just done to fill up the time. They told me I did not have to worry even if I did not go to any academic academy, and I was thankful they trusted me and never forced me to do anything.

I am mentor Jo Soo Bin, level 1 in English. English is not only needed for the SATs, but mandatory for major study and getting ready to get a job. You need to start from the basic and accumulate all elements of English, such as vocabulary, grammar, interpretation, listening and speaking, to meet the potential of SAT and future growth.

Q Mentor's studying method (English)

Reading

Reading speed in 1st and 2nd grade of high school can be slow. You can start to read fast when you read a lot of sentences so that you get the catch of the structure, and you start to see the structure of sentences. Even if the sentence is long, if you analyze the structure, you realize that it is composed in a very simple principle. If you repeat the practice of identifying nouns, adjectives, and adverbs, and distinguishing phrases and clauses, you will naturally start to see the structures.

Vocabulary

If you increase the vocabulary you memorize after growing sentence analysis skills, you will experience your reading ability increasing.

Grammar

I recommended you to focus studying by selecting a text book like 'Middle School English Grammar 3800' that has specific explanation and various types of questions you can solve.

Parent's support

I am very sensitive and get stressed out easily. Know my personality, my parents gave me full trust rather than intervening my studying environment. At the time I was playing around when my grades were not good in 3rd grade of high school, I remember my parents rather telling me to take a short break.



Mentor Lee Ji Yoon

I am mentor Lee Ji Yoon, level 1 in Korean. Korean was one of the subjects I got level 4~5 on average and had no confidence in. However, I want to tell you that you can reach your goal if you do not give up.

Q Mentor's studying method (Korean)

Literature

I studied the background of the period of the given work, information about the artist, and the subject first. If I organize it like this, I can apply the information I studied earlier to other works, so I looked more closely.

Non-literature

I always read the text after checking the questions first to shorten my problem solving time. I put circles and squares on words that I thought were keywords, and underlined the author's opinion. The experimental process or principle was indicated in each order with numbers, and the causal relationship was connected with an arrow to read the core of the text. At the end, I practiced finding important sentences by finding the details I needed for the question in the text. I recommend practicing solving a mock exam like the real SAT on one of the days in weekend.

Weekly plan

It was more effective for me to set a weekly plan and studying according to it. I wrote a daily plan according to the weekly plan.

For the subjects I am good at, I used the minimum study time and used my time efficiently.

Daily plan

I wrote the time I used just on the studying on the top of the planner, and I could feel the sense of achievement such as 'I have done this much!'.

I wrote the study time for each subject and made up for it the next day if a subject was not enough.

I organized it so that I could see the subjects I studied in a glance.

Parent's support

I was very stressed because I did not get a good grade in Korean even though it was an important subject for the entrance exam. Whenever I blamed myself for it, I remember my parents encouraging me by saying, "your grades will go up because you are doing your best.", and "it's okay."
